This float or sink experiment was a great way to preoccupy students thinking about what it is that makes materials float and sink.

Grade One, For our graduated kindergartners, they were no more kids having just fun all the time, they were learning serious subjects as math at home using a variety of household objects such as kitchen jars, toothpick, and candies.

For our little big kids of **Grade Two** distance means so little when there is a purpose. They were engrossed in Fun-Learning Activities like 'Internal and External Organs', 'Family Tree', 'World Earth Day'.

The young poets of **Grade Three** let their imagination run free with a poem 'The Tease' that describes a windy day. Later students expressed a windy day both by colours and by ink.

Grade Four, did so much more, because teachers had for them so much in store like power point presentation on authors and posters on preserving past history.

Grade Five took on the online classes with a high-five. They read books, shared views on authors, took on the place value system made into charts in their systems, started their journey with a seed ended up with a plant indeed.

A PLETHORA OF LANGUAGES FOR OUR STUDENTS AT THE PRIMARY WING

Children develop empathy and cultural understanding from learning different languages. DPS-Monarch gives an option of 5 different languages as Hindi, Malayalam, Tamil, French and Arabic as a Second Language from Grade I to V. From Grade III onwards, students have an option to choose from 8 different languages Hindi, Sanskrit, Malayalam, Tamil, French, Telugu, Arabic and Urdu as their Third Language. The online classes for second and third languages have given for some of our students an opportunity to learn the basics of some languages, for the advanced level learners, the ability to speak and think in different languages other than English.



Online Workshop on Assessment Tools

After the successful implementation of Microsoft Teams as one of the main platforms for conducting online classes in the secondary school, the school decided to further utilize Office 365 by conducting assessments using Microsoft Forms. A workshop was organized for the same by the IT department on 27th of April 2020, through Zoom App and was attended by all the teaching faculty of DPS Monarch.

Classes via Microsoft Teams in the Secondary Wing

With school being locked down due to COVID-19, educators of the school have moved to virtual classes on Microsoft Teams to ensure learning never stops. These video-enabled remote classrooms provide a host of interactive and collaborative tools on a single platform in remote learning scenarios. In the beginning, we started with Math, English, Science and SST classes but soon went ahead with Second and Third Languages, ICT, ART and Physical Education too. We are glad to inform you that, this year we included Sanskrit and Telugu as Third Languages in the academics. Every week, the teachers conscientiously prepare their E-Learning Lesson Plans which enable the parents and students to get aware of the lessons and activities to be taken by the teachers.

Poem, In The Morning Dew in English, Whole Numbers in Maths, Sources and Components of Food in Science, The Earth and Our Solar System in Geography were taught in Grade VI along with Physical Components in PE and Fundamentals of Computers in ICT by using various modes of teaching. In Grade VII Magical Story, Of Magic Lamps and Gines in English, Integers in Maths, Nutrition in Plants in Science and various other topics were taught in second and third languages along with ART, ICT and PE. Lessons 'The Eyes Have It' in English, 'Rational Numbers' in Math, 'Modern Period' in Indian History and 'Our Resources' in SST were taught by the teachers in Grade VIII via videos, PPT and worksheets. As part of the first chapter in Biology (Crop Production and Management) of VIII, students were asked to present the photos of terrace farming. Kiera Drea Pereira, a student of Grade VIII B has done vegetable cultivation on her terrace. This is really an encouragement for others, in this crisis situation the vegetables a family wants are cultivated by themselves. Art Teacher had created stunning paintings in her classes all these weeks by teaching different methods of drawing and painting to the students. The students are very keen for their ART classes. The Physical Education instructor had enlightened the students with the importance of physical fitness and made the students do different drills and exercises during the session. Students were at par in ICT classes too. They learnt about the process of 'Software Development of Life Cycle', 'Low level and High-level languages' through videos and online quiz. Various topics were taught in grade IX in different subjects. 'Factorization of Polynomials Using Identities' in Maths, 'The Lost Child' in English, 'Osmosis, States of Matter and Motion' in Science, 'The French Revolution' in History, 'Basic ICT Skills' in ICT, 'Different Exercises' in PE and Second Languages French and Arabic were taught by the teachers of Grade IX.
