An Inter-School Hindi Competition

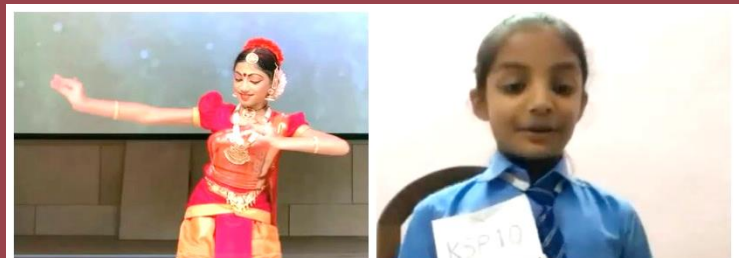

"THINGS I LIKE ABOUT ME"

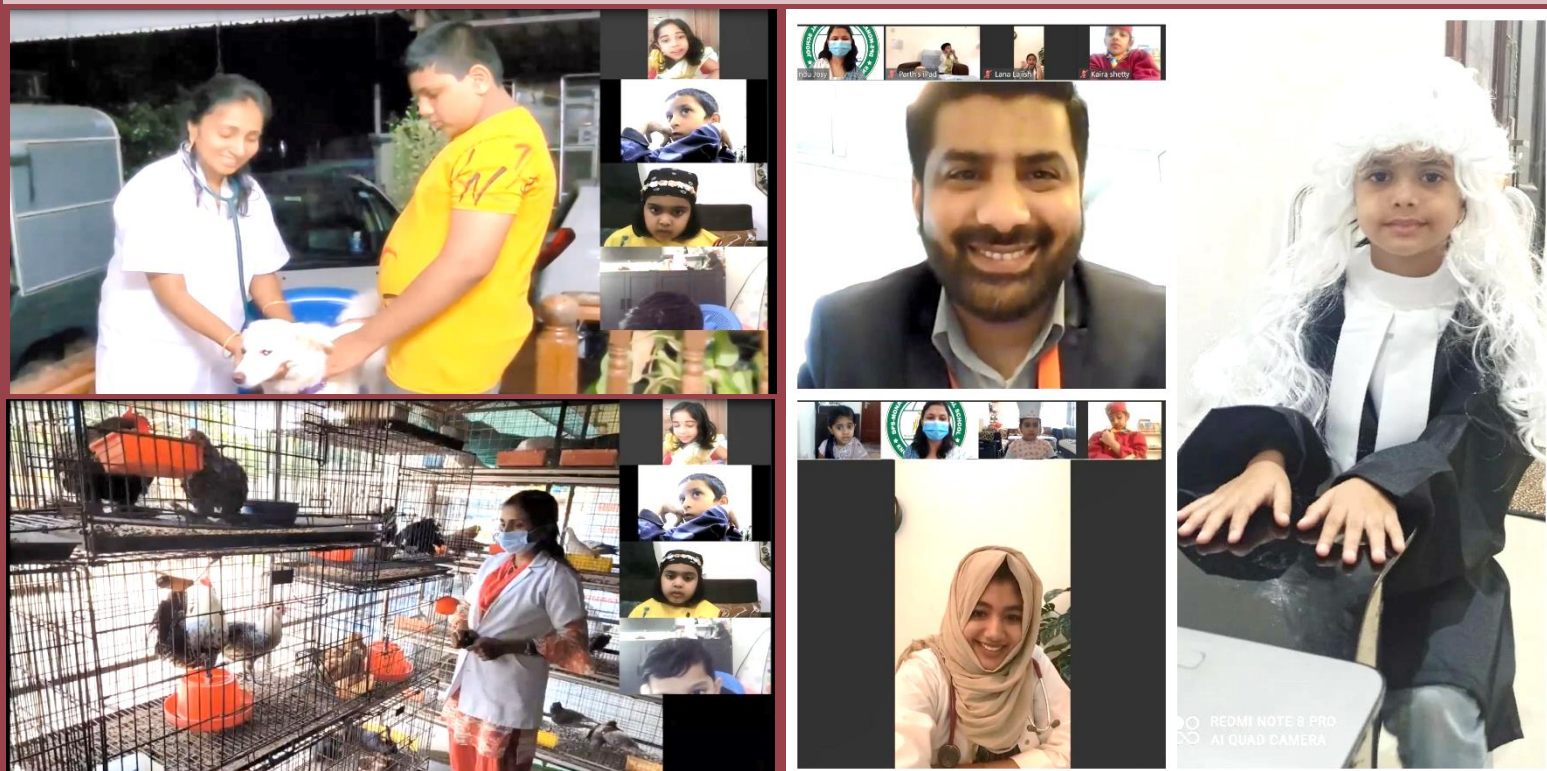

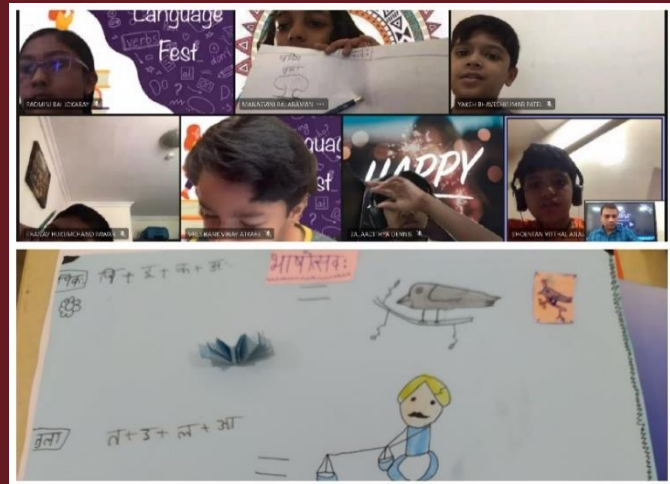


A SNEAK PEAK INTO THE PRIMARY WING

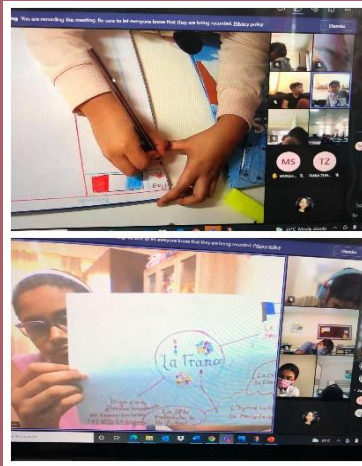

“Children talk when they are prompted or invited, or enabled and encouraged to do so, therefore the teacher’s role in promoting public speaking is absolutely crucial”

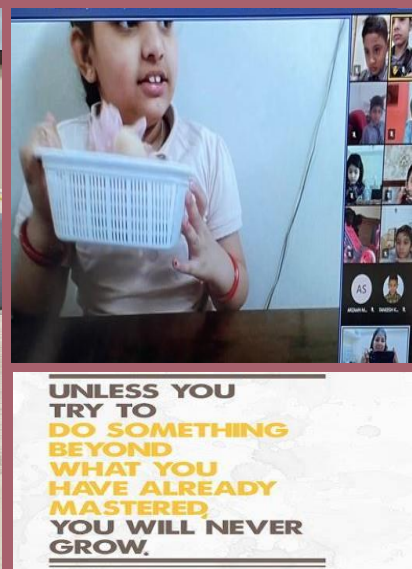

FIRST TERM EXAM REVISION WEEK

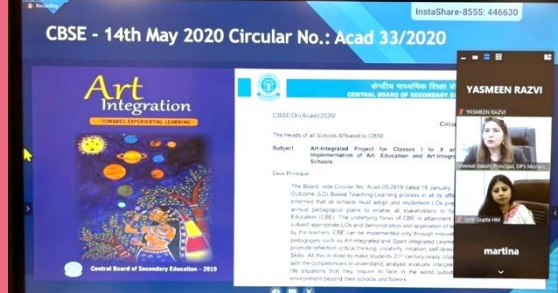
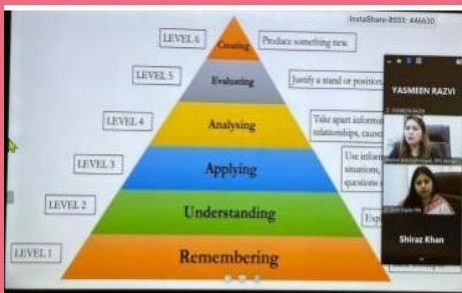
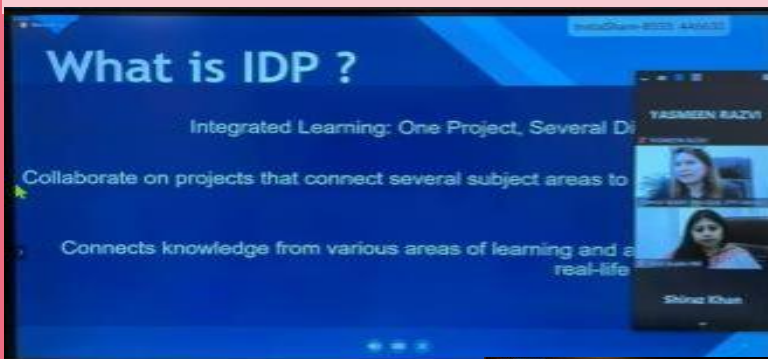
