Creative club activities



CBSE Board Exam - Grade X

The exam center was Birla Public School, Doha. Students were prepared by the assiduous and the most stalwart facilitators who primed them with thorough revision and guidance through multi extra classes, numerous revision worksheets and sample question papers to prepare them for the exam battle.

SAFAL ORIENTATION AND EXAM - GRADE V AND VIII

"The only limit to the height of your achievements is the reach of your dreams and your willingness to work for them."



We are delighted to share that our school, DPS Monarch International School has been selected by **CBSE** for the **SAFAL PILOT PROGRAM.**

Prime minister Narendra Modi has introduced a new framework named SAFAL (Structured Assessment For Analyzing Learning Levels), to assess the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) students for Grade V and VIII.

The Education Ministry said that the new framework will be used to assess around 50 lakh students in 25,000 CBSE schools across India though this will not be used in any manner by the schools for promoting students to the next grade.









As part of it, Structured Assessment For Analyzing Learning (SAFAL) a competency-based assessment for Grade V and VIII was conducted at DPS Monarch International School as a pilot test programme of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), to assess the progress of foundational skills and basic learning outcomes and competencies among the students.

It is a Competency-Based Assessment Framework to move away from the "Rote-Learning System" of heavy memorization which will reduce the students' fear and anxiety towards exams. They will have the curiosity to pursue new skills, new innovations, and the possibilities will be endless.

The orientation was given by the Secondary and Senior Secondary School Headmistress, **Ms. Madhu Uppal** along with Grade IX to XI Academic Coordinator, **Ms. Indira Dev Roy**, who is Nodal Teacher In charge for the program, to apprise the students with all the important information regarding the SAFAL Exam.

Key focus of the orientation was on developing Idea, Application, Problem Solving, more Interactive Teaching and Learning Techniques, Inquiry and Discovery-Based Learning and Discussion-Based learning and prepare students for CBSE SAFAL PILOT PROGRAM.

Assessment for Language, EVS, and Mathematics were planned for Grade V and for Grade VIII Assessment for Language, Science and Mathematics as per the schedule provided by the CBSE SAFAL UNIT for the PILOT PROGRAM. This assessment focused on testing core concepts, application of knowledge, and higher-order thinking skills which have ensured progress throughout the years by providing diagnostic information about students' learning to schools and thus, supporting school education to move towards competency-based education. The students actively attended the appraisal using their cognitive skills. The results of this assessment will largely be used to provide development feedback to schools and not for the promotion of students to the next grade.

Students of **Grade V and VIII** actively participated in SAFAL. To sum up, the results of this assessment will largely be useful to provide development feedback to schools and not for promotion of students to the next grade.




STREAM SELECTION AND CAREER PROSPECTS: ORIENTATION FOR GRADE X

DPS Monarch International School under its Mentoring Young Minds (MYM) Program conducted a virtual orientation for parents and students of Grade X on **Wednesday**, 8th February 2023.

As students are on the brink of moving from Grade X to XI, it is crucial for them to know about the career options available so that they can groom themselves accordingly. The session was held on **Stream Selection and Career Prospect by Ms. Reema Raheja**, Guidance and Career Counselor, under the guidance of the **Principal**, **Ms. Meenal Bakshi**, and Secondary and Senior Secondary School Headmistress, **Ms. Madhu Uppal**







The children reaching Grade XI cope with a strange and baffling situation of stream selection and feel unpromising later in life due to the wrong choice. Sometimes the students have a superficial knowledge about the subject combinations and the avenues linked to them, the school has organized one-hour session with the sole purpose of facilitating the children studying in Grade X and their parents to make the right decision in the very beginning and avoid any catastrophic situation in the later stage.

The program was spread over two segments, wherein the first segment was all about apprising the students and parents about the stream and subject combination availability in Grade XI, different career prospects, personality tests at the BridgeU platform, different criteria and procedures for stream selection. The second segment was a question-and-answer session, where parents and students clarified their doubts.

Numerous key elements related to career choices and subject combinations were discussed during the orientation examination. **Ms. Reema** emphasized that students and parents should consider "**Aptitude, Interest And Personality**" as essential keys in making decisions for Stream Selection.

Secondary and Senior Secondary School Headmistress, **Ms. Madhu Uppal** discussed the importance of having proper discussion with the parents and take their consent to choose the stream to avoid changes in the future. She also made the students aware not to get carried away by the peer pressure and select decisively your own subjects and stream. Emphasis was also laid on how one can improve oneself to get the stream of their choice. The Principal, **Ms. Meenal Bakshi** shared the relevance of skills of the future along with resources.

In general, this session was an engaging and informative session for the students and parents.

















These clubs are truly the platform for students to collaborate, learn and perform confidently and independently. Here are some glimpses of the Culmination Day of Club Activities.
