Safety is of paramount importance in any educational institution, and **DPS Monarch International School** takes this commitment seriously. As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure the safety of our students and staff, we conducted a fire drill on **6th and 7th September**, **2023 for Grades K.G. 1 to XII** to ensure the safety of the students and the staff. The primary objectives of the fire drill were as follows: Ensuring Familiarity, Testing Response Time and Practicing Fire Safety. The fire drill was informed prior through the circular, indicating that it was a drill and not a real emergency. Students and staff promptly evacuated their classrooms and offices, following the predetermined escape routes. Everyone gathered at the designated assembly point, where roll call was conducted to ensure that all students and staff were accounted for. The entire evacuation process, from the initial announcement to reaching the assembly point, was timed to evaluate the efficiency of the evacuation. After the drill, a debriefing session was held to inform the students with important information and instructions and Dos and Don'ts. The fire drill at our school reaffirms our commitment to the safety of our school community. It was a valuable exercise in ensuring that everyone is prepared and knows how to respond in case of a fire emergency. We will continue to refine our procedures and provide ongoing education to maintain a high level of safety awareness within our school.

# **CBSE TRAINING ONLINE**








#### TIME MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP
