Planned Activities & Action Points

Grade Level	Activity	Action-Oriented Details
Kindergarten 1	Recycled Craft – Sprout Pot Making	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bring a used plastic water bottle from home.• Decorate creatively using colors/stickers.• Fill with soil/cotton and plant seeds with parental support.• Care for the sprout and bring it on 4th June.• Present the sprout pot and share a few lines on reuse and caring for nature.• Dress Code: Green attire to support the initiative.
Kindergarten 2	Best Out of Waste Costume & Sprout Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prepare a costume using recyclable/waste materials.• Grow sprouts at home using recycled plastic bottle pots.• Bring both costumes and sprout on 4th June.• Students will present their costumes and explain its eco-friendly aspect.

<p>Grades 1&2</p>	<p>Trash to Treasure – Show & Tell</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are encouraged to make a simple craft using waste or recyclable materials at home with the help of parents. The craft should be brought to school for exhibition and Show & Tell. • Be prepared to say a few lines about your craft and how it helps reuse waste and protect the environment.
<p>Grades 3&4</p>	<p>“Young Eco Warriors” – Best Out of Waste Craft</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring recyclable materials (tissue rolls, paper cups, ice cream sticks, newspapers, plastic bottles). • Create a useful/decorative eco-friendly craft in school. • Be prepared to explain how the item promotes reuse and reduces waste.
<p>Grades 5–8</p>	<p>“Green corner initiative”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each class will create a <i>Green Corner</i> in the classroom, extending into the corridor. • Students bring indoor plants/saplings (e.g., money plant, spider plant, aloe vera). • Use eco-friendly materials (paper, jute, cardboard); avoid plastic. • Arrange plants neatly for a clean, green environment with student name and class. • Students will explain the importance of plants and green spaces in the class.
<p>Grades 9 & 11</p>	<p>Poster Making Competition</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a well-designed poster based on the theme: Grade 9: Renewable Energy and Sustainability Grade 11: Green Energy and Sustainability • Use effective slogans, visuals, and messages. • Ensure neat presentation and strong relevance to the topic.

- Students are encouraged to focus on creativity, originality, and practical understanding.


