This Qatar Debate Screening Notice is exclusively and mandatory for the Qatar Debate Work-Ex Club students from **Grade VII to XII** who are interested in participating in the Qatar Debate Leagues.

The students should report on **Thursday**, **29**th **May 2025** during the **club period** to their respective club In Charges for the screening round.

Grade 7 and 8 - FF 27 VIII B

Grade 9 to 12 - SF 38 IX D (Qatar Debate Club 1) and SF 08 X A (Qatar Debate Club 2)

Note:

Topic for debate screening – "Should parents have access to their children's social media accounts."

Students can speak individually either For or Against the topic given.

DURATION:

The speech should not exceed 1 minute in duration. The time limit will be strictly enforced.

CONTENT:

The speaker is expected to memorize his/her speech and is NOT allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes or cards.

Points will be awarded based on the following criteria:

CONTENT

- **4** Greeting and Introduction of the student.
- Exposition of the main topic (Conciseness and Clarity of Message, Originality/Points of Interest, Incorporation of Personal References and Quotations)
- Moral and Practical Application
- Conclusion

SPEAKING PRESENTATION

- Memorization (evaluated by pauses and amount of referring to index cards, if any)
- Verbal Clarity (Annunciation and pronunciation of words, voice strength and projection)

Presentation / Speaking Style (Mannerisms, judges contact and voice modulation, Ability to keep the judges engaged by their speaking style)

Selection of the debaters will be based on the above-mentioned criteria.

The shortlisted candidates will be informed about the registration process and further details to participate in the Qatar Debate Leagues later.

Round 2 of Screening for other students will be in the first week of June.
